



KATIKATI TWILIGHT CONCERTS

Tertiary Study Award 2022

The Twilight Concerts Tertiary Study Award is designed to recognise and assist Katikati students who have demonstrated artistic talent and potential and who are pursuing a career in the arts and related subjects. This award is also available to adult students who fit our criteria and reside in the designated area.

OBJECTIVES

- To financially assist Katikati students who intend to pursue or are already pursuing a career in the arts.
- To increase the number of artists in the Katikati region.
- To encourage the development of talent in the arts.

ELIGIBILITY

An applicant is eligible for consideration who:

- Is studying in any artistic field, in relevant studies at tertiary level, categories being: Music, Art, Drama, Stage & Film Production, Photography, Dance.
- Resides in, or whose family home is in, the Katikati area as defined by the boundaries of the Western Bay of Plenty District Council north of the Wairoa River.
- If shortlisted, following the application you will be required to attend an interview by appointment, the following week after closing on Monday November 29 2021.
- The successful applicants should be available to accept the award at the first Twilight Concert to be held on Saturday 8th January 2022 at the Haiku Reserve.

LEVEL OF FUNDING

- Up to two scholarships may be awarded in any one year.
- Each scholarship may be up to the value of \$3000 and must be processed within a twelve month period from notification.

HOW TO APPLY

Applicants must complete the application form: please also attach any relevant information.

The deadline for submitting the application is 5pm on Monday 29th November 2021 and applicants will be informed of the Committee's decision on 13th December 2021.

Applicants must supply the names and phone numbers of two people prepared to act as referees.
